This discount is subject to the conditions listed below:

- The \$15 discount is only applicable to routine well-pet office visits scheduled for the purpose of updating vaccinations.
- One or more members of the household must have lost a job on or after September 1, 2008 and be currently unemployed.
- There is a limit of three (3) discounts per household.
- The charges must be paid in full at the time that the services are provided.
- Proof of unemployment may be required (unemployment check, letter of termination, etc.)
